We apply to you as the representatives of the peoples`diplomacy in Estonia, and with our best intention we would like you to accept this photo album in which we, amateur historians, recorded the life of Konstantin Päts, the First President of the Estonian Republic (the events from 1988 to 2010).

The recollections go back to Russia, Tver Oblast, nearby Burashevo village where K.Päts died in the psychiatric hospital as a detainee and was buried in an unmarked grave in the old graveyard.

We are grateful to the local inhabitants, Kalininsky Municipality and the City Government of Tver Oblast who kindly and hospitably helped us, common people, and we were given letters of gratitude for the recording the biography of the first President of Estonia in the period when K. Päts was deported to Russia. We jointly founded the museum of K. Päts in Burashevo.

We hope that with your interest and kindness the museum of Konstantin Päts will be established also in the homeland of K. Päts.

Up to now we have placed the boulder with the memorial plaque to mark the burial ground of K. Päts near Burashevo village and we paid for the expenses to keep the place in order.

We look forward to the day when the compact monument of all the presidents of the Estonian Republic will be erected in our capital so that our people and guests from afar will have public access to the monument and remember our history as is the custom in most European countries.

Nowadays we can see the bas-relief of **President Boris Yeltsin of the Russian Federation** who with no doubt has deserved the greatest honour.

History is history, monuments and bas-reliefs of any kind are valuable reminders of the past in spite of the fact that value judgements to great personalities change as time goes by.

We wish everlasting life to the Republic of Estonia and the Estonian people.
